

Termination Policy

The Termination Policy of Ink & Fable Publishing Ltd. outlines the procedure followed by the Founding Team if any author fails to follow policy rules.

1. Procedure for Reviews

Authors who do not follow the rules outlined in the policies outlined by Ink & Fable Publishing will be put under review and will potentially have their contracts nulled by Ink & Fable Publishing Ltd. therefore terminating their working relationship with this manuscript and future manuscripts. The Ink & Fable Publishing founders will put the matter under review, taking into account how the author in question did not follow policy rules. The founders will come to a decision on what action will be taken as a result by following the procedure outlined below.

- Author and manuscript put under review
- Founding Team to assess which policy was not followed and how
- Founding Team will come to a decision for action to take based on severity of breach
- Team and author will have meeting to discuss breach and action taken

2. Nulled Contracts

If the Founding Team decides to null a contract during their review, then the author and founders will be required to sign a new contract stating that the Publishing Contract is null and void. Authors may then take their manuscript to other publishers or publish themselves as they are no longer publishing that manuscript through Ink & Fable Publishing.

If the review deems that the breach of policy requires a nulled contract then the author may still be permitted to submit future manuscripts to Ink & Fable. However, if the author has multiple contracts nulled due to breach of policy, then the author will be no longer permitted to submit to Ink & Fable Publishing Ltd.
